

- The more early of the start, the more detail you get and the chance to be success is close to your dream
- When to start
- At high risk ANC clinic
- At labor room (high risk pregnant woman)
- At NICU
- At step 1 of BF in sick baby
- Not at one day before discharge


Well cooperation between the team





Process of rooming-in and evaluation

- Need to adjust to the context of individual hospital
- Room type and vacancy
- Chronological order management
- Criteria for readiness of both mom and baby/babies

Process of rooming-in and evaluation

Baby readiness

Physical maturity (chrolonogical age)

Progression of 10 steps in BF

Mom readiness

Emotional, belief, religion

Attitudes, Free time

Distance from house to hospital

Criteria fitting for discharge

- The goal is corresponding with the teaching program of the institute
- The check list may be use to make sure to complete the whole evaluation
- Setting clear goal
- Good communication between HCWs, continuous monitoring and follow up un-pass goal with avoid duplicating works
- Criteria for discharge the baby (general/specific)

Criteria fitting for discharge

baby Feeding well

- Maturity
- Sucking and swallowing ablilty
- Sleep-wake cycle

mom Learning hungry cue / milk production

- Confident
- Problems solving skills
- Contact list (when needs help)

Continuing quality improvement

- Data gathering
- Information database
- Case review/conference
- Monitoring successful of BF after discharge
- Developing new strategy to improve the outcome

Summary...

- Preparing for discharge or discharge planning is a major way to enhanced smooth transition for patient from hospital to home.
- It compose of identification, assessment, goal setting, planning, implementation, coordination and evaluation.

A good beginning is half the battle.
